President Geng thanked everyone for coming and reminded everyone how important they are. He explained that many came as early as June 26<sup>th</sup>. Both the State and Local Chapter worked together and separately on their responsibilities. Recognition and thanks were given to the women who worked extremely long and hard on volunteer lists and assignments. Nancy Miller was thanked for her work prior to GNR.

Vice President Tom Mosteter, filling in as secretary, informed the membership the minutes of the 2011 meeting was posted on the club website. A motion was made by Ed Potts to accept the Secretary's report as posted and was seconded by Mike Isebrand. The motion was voted on and carried.

Treasurer Ben Crabtree read the Treasurer's report. It was reported that \$1758.67 was in the checking account as of June 30, 2011. The club had an income of \$284.00 and expenses of \$1027.18, leaving a balance of \$1015.49 in the checking account and \$31.44 in petty cash as of July 19, 2012. There is an outstanding bill for name badges for \$24.00. He also reported IALCP has a current membership of 68, with 22 expiring at the conclusion of GNR this year. He asked that anyone needing to renew their membership see himself or Pat. The report was accepted and filed for audit.

#### New Business

President Geng explained that both Presidents Clubs had jointly held bingo nights with this year's proceeds of \$76.25 going to the GNR Youth Group. This money, along with other contributions, help fund the GNR Youth Group. A motion was made by Carol Johnson that the IALCP give an additional \$50.00 to the GNR Youth Group and was seconded by Paul Riehm. The motion was voted on and carried.

The bench jointly ordered last year by the Presidents Clubs was assembled and placed by the Presidents Clubs' row this year. The joint website for the Presidents Clubs is paid for the next 3 years. The page is linked through the Winnebago website under

Special thanks was given to Ed and Carol Gies for their great efforts. Being no other business, Ed moved to adjourn and Carol seconded the motion. Motion voted on and carried. Meeting adjourned 10:37 July 19, 2012 at GNR.
